COMPLAINT

Comes now the Plaintiff, Allison Altes, by and through her attorney, Gregory T. Karber, and for her Complaint against the Defendant, Robert E. Altes, states:

1. The Plaintiff is a citizen and resident of the City of Fort Smith, Sebastian County, Arkansas. The Defendant is a citizen and resident of the City of Fort Smith, Sebastian County, Arkansas. This is a complaint for an absolute divorce. This Court has jurisdiction and proper venue lies herein.


5. The parties have acquired certain real and personal property during the course of their marriage, all of which should be divided pursuant to Arkansas law.
