& screams at me and calls me a whore. He yells cuss
words at me all the time and tells me that I don't do any-
thing right (cooking, cleaning, etc.) He tells me that I owe him. He says
I'm going to pay him back for everything that I've done, when I
haven't done anything. He has locked me out of the house
three times in the last four months. One time I had to spend the
night in the car. About three weeks ago when my son hurt his
shoulder he pushed a stretcher into my side when we were in the
emergency room.

about 5 to 7 years ago he pushed me down
some steps at the Valley View School gym with other people around.
It broke my ankle. He got mad because I couldn't do things for
him. The doctor told me to stay off of the ankle. Jack told me I could
do just as much in the wheel chair as I could standing.

October 26th of 1998 he broke a mirror and didn't
clean it up. I ~~was~~ cut my foot on the glass and had to
seek medical attention.

Thanksgiving he was trying to put a bed in a room
and got mad because it wouldn't fit. He got mad and broke
out a window.

Things are escalating to the point where I think
the verbal abuse is again going to turn physical. I'm
scared of what he might do next time he gets mad.
